In addition to the scientific papers pHealth 2014 offers an opportunity for young researchers to present and discuss their work in the international community: The pHealth 2014 Student Poster Contest. The contest winners will receive a reward. Additionally the 5 best submissions will have the opportunity to publish their work as a paper in the European Journal for Biomedical Informatics (<http://www.ejbi.org>), an official journal of the European Federation for Medical Informatics (EFMI).

Submission of Student Poster Contest paper

In order to qualify for the contest students first hand in a paper. The paper structure includes: Title, names, and affiliations (city, state, and country) of all authors, abstract (up to 200 words), 4-6 keywords. The body of the text shall include: introduction, methods, results, discussion, conclusions and references. The maximum length of a paper submission is two A4 camera-ready pages, and should strictly follow the formatting rules of the provided [IOS Press template](#).

Topics of interest for the Student Poster Contest include but are not limited to:

- Wearable and implantable devices and systems
- Solutions for personalized care
- Data and Knowledge Management and Methodologies
- Interoperable ICT and Telemedicine
- mHealth Applications
- Security, Privacy, Safety and Ethics in pHealth

More detailed topic areas are listed in the “Call for Papers” of pHealth 2014, on the conference website.

Please submit the paper electronically in pdf format to stefan.sauermann@technikum-wien.at. The deadlines listed below are mandatory.

The papers will be reviewed by a jury, and the authors will be notified about acceptance for the contest. The main author must register on the conference website and present the poster in person.

Poster format and poster session at the conference

The mandatory poster format is A0, portrait. The authors will produce and print their posters and take them to the conference themselves. Instructions on where to place the posters will be provided on site. Pin boards for mounting the poster and needles for fixing them will be available.

The main authors of Student Contest posters present their posters in a 3-5 minute “lightning talk” within the moderated poster session of the conference. The decision of the jury will be based on the submitted paper, the poster and the presentation.
